



Barossa Farmers Market Community Stall Guidelines

The following guidelines are in place for the use of a community table on a vacant position within the market, that takes place on a non-regular basis.

The opportunity is offered for – small back yard growers with small amounts of produce, registered charities, incorporated not-for-profit organisations, local schools (or other education providers) and other Barossa community groups or organisations to attend the farmers market on an available stall, on a once off or occasional basis.

- When the community stall holder wishes to use a community table on a regular basis (greater than 4 times per year), then they therefore need to apply to become regular stallholder with regular fees payable.
- The community stall holder will be accepted when market management has been asked in advance and the product they are selling comes under the Barossa Farmers Market's ethos.
- All community table holders will be measured against the current market mix, so they do not compromise existing stallholder businesses.
- All community stall holders who are growers must complete relevant sections of the stallholder application form and must be a market member.

Where applicable community stall holders must provide details of:

- Primary produce/value added food or non-food farm type products (plants, compost etc) to be sold
- Certificate of currency (if it is an organisation)
- Food business notification number, kitchen approval by council, and licences or certification (if applicable). This is needed when selling value added products

Schools, charities and not-for-profit fundraising

- The promotion and sales of raffle tickets or similar items must be approved in advance by Market Management.
- Religious organisations and other local groups would be permitted to operate a stall but not to use the market for recruitment or to promote their beliefs.
- Collecting signatures for petitions and the distribution of flyers is not permitted within the market unless prior Board approval has been given.
- Schools, charities and not-for-profit groups can also sell merchandise and non-food items with management approval to raise money for school-based activities or charities.

Cost:

The cost will be \$20 for the use of a table, or if only requiring a portion of the table, can be split into increments if sharing the table and depending of the amount of table space used (subject to the market managements discretion).

Please note that spaces are very limited and is subject to availability. The opportunity is provided primarily for the sale of fresh produce (ie fruit and vegetables) and the current availability of similar items in the market may be taken into account when granting permission. Approval is required for all stalls in advance – please ensure that applications are submitted at least two weeks prior to the requested date to attend.
