



BAROSSA FARMERS MARKET COMMUNITY STALL GUIDELINES

The following guidelines are in place for the use of our Community Stall at the market.

Our Community Stall is available for pop-ups and can be rented a maximum of 4 times per year by one of the following:

- Barossa residents who have grown too much produce in their vegetable garden or orchard
- Bakers who wish to sell their home baked goods
- Flower and plant growers to sell their seasonal products
- Registered charities and incorporated not for profits
- Local schools or other educational providers
- Local community groups

All applicants should complete our Community Stall Application Form at least 7 days prior to their anticipated attendance date.

All our stallholders are measured against our Market Matrix to ensure we do not compromise the sales of other stallholders. Occasionally one or more of the products you wish to sell may not meet our criteria.

We ask that you provide as much detail as possible in your application. As provenance and sustainability is important to the market, we would like to know that you have thought about what you are selling, where your ingredients come from and how it will be presented and packaged. Supporting photographs will help us to understand your product more.

If you are an existing business wishing to trial a stall at the market, you will also need to provide:

- A certificate of currency
- A food business notification and proof of approval by your local Council

If you wish to sell raffle tickets or promote a cause, approval must be obtained in writing from the Barossa Farmers Market General Manager.

Religious organizations and local groups are not allowed to use the Community Stall for recruitment purposes or to promote their own beliefs. Likewise, petitions or the distribution of flyers is not permitted anywhere at the Barossa Farmers Market.

If you are a school group, we require someone over 18yrs to be present during your attendance.

Should you wish to rent our Community Stall for more than 4 times per year, a regular stallholder application form should be completed, which will need to be reviewed by the Board.

Our Community Stall costs \$20 per Saturday, payable on the day of trading.
